1. Program Overview

- Global Energy Technology Policy Professionals Program (GETPPP) is a part of Global Talent Training Program supported by the Ministry of Climate, Energy, Environment (MCEE) of the Republic of Korea and the Korea Institute of Energy Technology Evaluation (KETEP).
- GETPPP is a Master's and Doctoral degree program to educate government officials and specialists in the field of energy technology and policy in emerging countries.
- Our mission is to contribute to the inclusive energy development of emerging countries and promote strong and close cooperation.
- GETPPP aims to develop a solid foundation for the expansion of cooperation in the energy sector by establishing an energy and human network among nations, academia, and the private sector.
- Facilitate the access of Korean companies to the global energy markets through global energy networks and platforms.

2. Qualifications

- A government official in related areas (Ministry of Energy, Ministry of Natural Resources, Ministry of Industry and Trade, etc.)
- An energy specialist working at the national electric/power companies
- A bachelor's or master's degree (Applicants for a doctoral degree must hold a master's degree)

3. Scholarship

- The successful applicants will enroll in the 2027 Spring Semester (starting in March) according to Korea University academic year, and a regular scholarship will be granted as followed.
 - Tuition (Master's students: up to 2 years, Doctoral students: up to 3 years)
 - Stipend: 1,600,000 KRW per month (including National Health Insurance fee)
 - One-way Airfare (actual amount up to 1,500,000 KRW)
 - Korean language and Culture Programs
 - Costs of textbooks and labs activities

4. Admissions Time Line

- October 7th (Wed), 2026 ~ October 21th (Wed), 2026:
 - Submission of application form via email to getppp@korea.ac.kr
- October 28th (Wed), 2026 ~ November 3rd (Tue), 2026: Entering Applicant Information into the Application System
 - * Instructions for entering the information will be provided after the application submission period has ended.
- November, 2026: Document screening, an oral interview if necessary
- December 10th (Thu), 2026: Notification of admission
- ~ December 30th (Wed), 2026
 - Submission of the original degree certificate and the academic transcript with an Apostille or consular legalization by email to getppp@korea.ac.kr and by postal mail.
 - *Please check the instructions regarding the final degree certificate and transcript at the end of the document.

- January, 2027: Preparation of arrival (Visa, Dormitory, etc.)
- February, 2027: Arrival in Korea
- March 2nd, 2027: Beginning of spring semester 2027

* The schedule for document screening, oral interviews, and announcement of successful applicants may be subject to change during the admissions process.

5. Important Notice for All Applicants

- ① Only the original copies will be acceptable and photocopied, scanned or faxed documents will not be permitted.
- ② If the documents are not written in English, please submit the notarized documents (within 3 months) translated in English.
- ③ The spelling of your name and the birth date must be matched those shown in your passport.
- ④ None of the submitted records and documents are returnable.
- ⑤ Important notice will be announced by e-mail. Please indicate email address 1 and email address 2 accurately. They should have the different email account each other (yahoo, hotmail, gmail, and etc).
- ⑥ If any of the submitted materials contain false information, admission will be rescinded.
- ⑦ Applicants should take full responsibility for any disadvantages due to the mistakes or omissions on the application.

Regarding the final degree certificate and the academic transcript, which are required submission documents:

In accordance with the regulations of the Korean Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Justice,

1) For applicants from countries* that are members of the Apostille Convention:

You must submit a scanned copy of the original degree certificate and the academic transcript with an Apostille by December 30 (Wed) via the GETPPP email and by postal mail.

2) For applicants from countries* that are not members of the Apostille Convention:

You must obtain consular legalization for your final degree certificate and academic transcript from the Korean embassy in your country and submit a scanned copy by December 30 (Wed) via the GETPPP email and by postal mail.

***Please note that “countries” refers to the country where the university that awarded your highest degree is located, not your country of nationality.**

***Attached please check the list of Apostille Convention member countries.**

<Details>

-All original admission documents submitted will not be returned. Therefore, if you only have one original copy of a document, you must have a notarized copy made and submit that copy with an apostille or consular legalization.

-The applicable authentication method depends on the country where your final degree was awarded. For example, if you are a Nepalese national but completed your master's degree in France, you must obtain an Apostille, as France is a member of the Apostille Convention.

-Please note that the Apostille takes priority. Consular legalization is only valid if the country in question is not a member of the Apostille Convention. Kindly keep this in mind.

-Degree certificates or academic transcripts issued in languages such as Sinhala or Vietnamese must first be translated into English. After obtaining a notarized translation, you must then proceed with consular legalization or obtain an Apostille.

-Considering that obtaining an apostille or consular legalization may take a considerable amount of time, during the application period (scheduled from October 7 to October 21), submission of the final degree certificate and academic transcript in English will be provisionally accepted as a valid application. However, it is strongly emphasized that if the apostilled or consularly legalized documents are not submitted by December 30, the admission offer will be automatically revoked, even if the applicant has been notified of acceptance on December 10.

-If you have completed your undergraduate or master's degree at a university in the Republic of Korea, you may print out your diploma and academic transcript from the university's official website and submit them accordingly.

-The above documents must be submitted in their original form. Copies will not be accepted, and the original documents will not be returned. Please prepare multiple original copies in advance to avoid requesting the return of the documents at a later date.
